Fix the Fells is a partnership between the National Trust, the Lake District National Park, Natural England, Nurture Lakeland and Friends of the Lake District.



THE NEED

The Lake District fells are a walkers' paradise, attracting millions of visitors annually. But erosion from people – coupled with the increasing frequency of severe weather events – is causing ugly scars and environmental damage in the fragile mountains.



IMPACT

- **Protecting the Lake District for future generations**
- **Enhancing the landscape of the fells**
- **Removing ugly erosion scars that can be seen for many miles**
- **Improving water quality for plant and fish life**
- **Protecting upland habitats for rare plant species**
- **Preserving carbon in upland peat**
